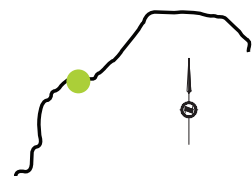
Key Features of This Section

The SFPR Project preserves and enhances the **wildlife corridor** that spans from the Fraser River and creates a vital ecological animal access to and from Burns Bog and the Fraser River. Improvements and long-term benefits for wildlife from small mammals to birds and deer includes:

- A stream that will provide a greater diversity of wildlife habitats
- Water features
- Riparian habitat and bird nest cavities created from salvaged trees
- Wetland habitat supporting waterfowl, birds, and vegetation

SFPR's **award-winning Landfill Closure Project**, in cooperation with the Corporation of Delta and private land owners, located south of the Fraser River and north of Burns Bog was both an environmental and socioeconomic success, revitalizing five under-used industrial land areas while increasing protection for Burns Bog.

Sections of the landfills were safely and securely closed and covered. A robust leachate and methane gas collection system was designed and built to improve the environment in the area. The system has enough capacity to allow adjacent landfill owners to connect to it so they can cap and close their own landfills and develop industrial land. Development in this area is already taking place.
